
Surgical Films: How to upload an unlisted YouTube video




Navigate to https://www.youtube.com




Sign in to YouTube with your Google account. If you do not have a Gmail, you will need to create one.




After signing in, you will be redirected to the YouTube homepage.



Click on the video camera to begin your upload process. Select "upload video."




On the upload page, click the dropdown menu to make your upload "<u>unlisted.</u>" This will make your video invisible to searches and it will not appear on your YouTube channel.




Next, click on the white arrow to choose the file to upload. A window will pop up for you to navigate to your video file. Hit "open" once you have clicked on your file.

YouTube supports the following file formats:


MOV, MPEG4, MP4, AVI, WMV, MPEGPS, FLV



Once, you begin the upload process, you can list the title and description for your video. You MUST stay on this page until the upload process is complete, as indicated by the progress bar.



Once the upload is complete, you can copy/paste the link in the left-hand corner of the upload screen. This is the link that you will provide with your submission.



REMEMBER:

- Films cannot exceed 10 minutes in duration.
- Films must include sound.
- Films must be at regular speed.
- Films may not be biased to a product or institution. Efforts should be made to cover logos or product names, if possible.
- You will be notified by November 2019 of your film's status for the SGO 2020 Annual Meeting. If you are not contacted by November 30, contact education@sgo.org. Be sure to include your submission ID number.
